KIRCO MANIX is putting the final touches on a 20,000 s.f. renovation for St. Paul of Tarsus Catholic Church in Clinton Township, Michigan.

The project included complete removal and replacement of an unconventional roofline, along with interior renovations to the sanctuary including new lighting, HVAC and flooring.

This complicated roofing project involved removal and replacement of the existing copper roof system originally installed in the 1980's. The roofing was replaced with the most watertight copper roofing system available: a well-crafted, double-locked standing seam roof with soldered traverse seams. All of the panel seams were hand tooled.
